Five local Christian leaders completed the inaugural two-year training program in 2022 and fifteen more arrived on Saturday, March 4 for "round 2". Hugo (pictured above, second from left) entered the course as a local church congregant, became highly engaged in the learning and is now preaching and encouraging others.

Ten women learned various skills this past year, and have brought that training back to their homes and into their communities to generate income for their families. Some are taking their newly-developed skills one step further and 'paying it forward' by teaching those same skills to others near and far.

The 2021 Raising Rufus campaign culminated in 2022 with the replacement of Skylark's largest roof surface. Families in the community in turn received "new-to-them" roofs over their heads.

The Skylark Centre played host to 56 groups with over 4,400 attendees during 2022 and have already seen over 700 come through the gates in the first two months of this year. This adorable 4-year-old lives with his aunt. His dad is an absentee parent, and his mom had no choice but to seek employment in another community. He sees her only once or twice a month. Enyel's aunt, recognizing that his shyness, quietness and even fearfulness were problematic, registered him at the "Best Start in Christ" preschool last year. She felt it was his best option to learn, socialize and be a part of a larger caring family.

Although hurdles remain, his teachers have seen a marked improvement over the past year in his social skills and his ability to interact with his classmates. His ability to stay on task is improving. We pray for Enyel, and for all of the children God has placed in our care.
