MINISTRY HELPS MOM AND DAUGHTER



Last July, Maria Marcelina and her infant daughter, Britany, visited the Skylark medical clinic. Maria was diagnosed with post partum depression while little Britany presented with serious health concerns which included being underweight and having reflux issues. Maria admitted to having suicidal thoughts and urges to hurt her baby. Her sickness meant there were times when she left Britany home alone all day long. Britany's father was working in Managua and did not know about the situation. Skylark staff committed to helping Maria because, in her depression, she felt incapable of looking after her child and feared for their future. Treatment was provided for Maria's depression as well as for Britany's health concerns. Maria and Brittany live in Fatima, a community 12 km away, and Skylark was able to provide transportation for them so they could participate in the Best Start in Christ Program. With the support of the program and follow up care, Maria is gradually overcoming her depression. Improvement has been noted in the way she interacts with Britany and in her increasing selfconfidence to care for her daughter. Britany's health has also improved and she is meeting some of the significant childhood milestones like taking her first steps! OUTREACH MINISTRY HIGHLIGHTS 2014

2014 was a full year of outreach ministry in Nicaragua!

Best Start in Christ

Prenatal and Infant Care

- 45 women attended prenatal and infant care classes and received Welcome Baby packages. 7 of them were teenagers between 14-16 years old.
- 5 women were transported safely to the hospital to give birth.
- 3750 prenatal vitamins were distributed.
- 17 obstetric ultrasounds were sponsored.
- 37 babies were born in the area 11 prenatal talks were given

Newborn

12 newborns and their mothers attended the program.

Moms'n Tots

Between 10 - 16 mothers and their one year olds were encouraged in their abilities as young moms to connect with and help their children develop. **Preschool**

- 9 children graduated from the Best Start in Christ Preschool.
- 59 children have graduated from the program since 2009.

Change a Life

15 children were sponsored.5 of them graduated from the program.

Medical Ministry

- 2,118 patients were seen by the 3 medical teams
- 9 follow up consultations were arranged
- 138 lab tests, ultrasounds, x-rays and biopsies were performed
- 203 dental patients were seen by the January dental team Work included extractions,
 - cleanings, restorations, xrays & fluoride treatments

Paramedic Training

17 participants from different communities were trained in First Aids and Pre Hospital Care. 6 of them were firemen.

- 22 doctors and nurses attended the training at the Hospital in linotepe.
- 3 First Aid kits were renewed and 4 were refilled. (These were given during Phase I in April 2014)

Teams Youth

We hosted a combined youth/ adult team from St. Andrew's Parry Sound in March. They came to help in several areas such as: painting, ministry, and sports.

Pastoral Ministry

- 19 pastoral couples received refreshment and renewal through a marriage retreat.
- 54 participants received instruction about how to treat and deal with their children and families.

Youth Outreach

About 200 neighbourhood kids participated in VBS activities

NEW INITIATIVE FOR 2015

BUILDING A BETTER FUTURE WITH MY HANDS is an exciting new 2015 initiative for the Skylark Centre. It is geared towards women from local communities around the Centre with the main objective of helping to develop their skills so they may contribute to their family's income. A parallel goal is to help raise the self-esteem of each participant as their handiwork will be made available for sale to both North American and Nicaraguan visitors to Skylark.

The program will focus on providing the participants with the necessary skills to make marketable crafts. The training will be divided into four modules which consist of foam crafts, card making, costume jewellry and embossed aluminum. The women will be given 70 hours of training over 35 weeks. They will attend two hour sessions every Wednesday afternoon from March through to October. At the end of each module, a certificate of completion will be granted to every participant.

Please pray for these women who are endeavouring to apply themselves to learning new skills. This program has the potential to have a sizeable impact on their lives. Thank you for your ongoing support!
