

# Annual Report 2016



# Together we are empowering a community.

Thank you for taking a few minutes to journey with us as we look back through 2016. We are excited to share a summary and some highlights of what has transpired over the last year in Nicaragua and beyond. It might sound cliché, but we thank God that lives truly are being changed and we could not be more thrilled!

- 5,000 guests were welcomed to the Skylark Retreat Centre in 2016; this was a full 1,000 more than in 2015. This means that 20% more people were involved in Christian events, received Christian-based instruction, benefitted from various forms of training or health care, and more.
- 42 of the events at the Skylark Retreat Centre were specifically Nicaraguan (local); 31 of these Christian events catered to youth and children, while the remainder were geared towards women, couples, teachers and pastors
- Through your support of the Best Start in Christ programs we touched the lives of 30 children and walked alongside 28 mothers-to-be
- The Building a Better Future program saw 5 'graduates' women who have received trained in new skills, been provided with a start-up package of materials, and received educated in basic business finance. The training and microfinancing will aid these women as they work to bring in much-needed income to their families.
- 600 community members attended medical and/or dental clinics on-site, and almost 500 prescriptions were issued and filled
- 50 individuals, many of them volunteer firefighters, received basic and intermediate first-response training, and 20 emergency (i.e. enhanced first-aid) kits were distributed
- 26 couples involved in local Christian ministry received training, guidance, advice and materials geared specifically to them and the important and unique roles they play as they guide their community members

So many have been touched. Thank you for supporting this work and may God bless you. We look forward to your continued partnership in 2017.



# A fresh start

An observation by one of our medical team doctors led to a diagnosis of Human papillomavirus (HPV) in one of the young mothers who was participating in our Best Start program. The resulting infection was quite worrisome. After many tears, prayers and much support by our Skylark staff, and with intensive medical treatment, her infection has cleared! She has expressed her thanks to Threefold throughout the ordeal indicating that Threefold has been a light and a great blessing in her life and to the larger community.



# Continuity of care

Some time back, another of our visiting medical teams diagnosed a child of 4 with diabetes. Her mother was provided with monitoring equipment, and diabetes education. She continued her education as participant with the First-Response teams, returning this year for a refresher. Distraught after losing the glucometer, a team member was able to source one, plus supplies for her. What she shares with us says it all:
