



Medical "clinica" up and running!



It happened! The new on-site medical clinic at the Skylark Centre, geared to identified local residents with chronic health conditions, became a reality on July 27th. 16 patients are being served in this pilot phase, being attended to bi-monthly by Dr. Martinez. Regular team interpreter Bildad, is serving as medical assistant, responsible for translating the medical records into English for the benefit of visiting North American medical mission teams.

Prior to the clinics, none of the patients had access to medication, with much being unaffordable or unavailable. We are already incurring additional costs in supplying further medications and tests to provide treatment that can extend beyond the chronic conditions themselves. A single patient presented with a blood sugar level of 22 (normal range is 4-7), for which she was immediately treated; a glucometer with test strips is being sourced for her specifically. All patients are receiving information pamphlets and basic health kit supplies.

A first-time patient stood up on August 10th to pray her blessing over the clinic. We are collectively blessed—thanks to God, and in great part to your ongoing support!

- Foot-care; providing specialized treatment and local practitioner training
- Paramedical; continuing to provide first-response training to firefighters
